GUIDELINES AND MARKING SCHEME FOR PERFORMANCE-BASED TEST:

- a. All candidates applying for M.A. Music will have to appear for the Performance-Based test.
- b. For the purpose of merit, 40% weightage will be given to the DUET score obtained from the Program-Specific eligibility and 60% weightage will be given to the score obtained from the Performance-Based Test.
- c. The number of candidates being called for the offline Performance-Based Test is as per the guidelines of the University of Delhi.

DETAILS OF CONDUCTING THE PERFORMANCE-BASED ENTRANCE TEST:

1. Venue for the Practical Entrance Test for all the candidates is:

- 2. The Test will be conducted in offline mode only. No request for conducting the test in online mode will be entertained.
- 3. The reporting time for all the candidates is 9:00 a.m.
- 4. The Performance-based test/s of the candidates from outside Delhi NCR will be done according to the list published herewith. No separate list will be prepared for outstation candidates
- 5. At the time of the Test, candidates are required to bring a hard copy of the result of the DUET 2022, conducted by NTA, as well as the CSAS documents.
- 6. Parents/guardians/relatives of the candidates shall not be allowed inside the venue.
- 7. Candidates have to check their respective dates of Performance-based Test/s from the Department of Music website <u>music.du.ac.in</u> as well as their respective <u>email ids</u> for further information. No enquiry shall be entertained via email or whatsapp.
- 8. The Department of Music will provide the instruments & accompanists for the Performance-based Test/s. Those who wish to bring their own **manual instruments** may do so after due registration, well in advance, at the office of the Department.
- 9. Harmonium / Sarangi accompaniment shall be allowed only for the candidates appearing for M.A Percussion Music-Tabla/Pakhawaj and not for candidates of M.A.Music (Hindustani Vocal).
- 10. Candidates will not be allowed to use their electronic instruments during the Practical Entrance Tests.
- 11. No TA/DA will be paid to any candidate.
